The AEO-certificate is granted to enterprises based in the EU and processing customs-relevant business transactions.

After a comprehensive audit by the chief customs office Koblenz, BUSE gets the AEO-certificate in variant C "Customs law simplifications". This certifies BUSE compliance with customs regulations as well as an effective quality management.

As an authorised economic operator, BUSE has got a special status as a reliable and trustworthy partner in international management of goods. So, customs formalities can be handled more quickly and more efficiently. The status of the authorised economic operator so signifies a **high quality as well as a transparent and trustworthy business policy with BUSE**. Customers will benefit from the simplified customs clearing upon import and export.

The approval procedure is attached to comprehensive conditions BUSE fulfils for obtaining the status AEO C. To these belong reliability, solvency as well as fulfillment of applicable legislation as some of the most important requirements to BUSE. The grant of the certificate is followed by regular inspections by the customs administration. In addition, there is the obligation to inform the customs authorities on important changes. Constant compliance with the rules as well as a trouble-free process of the customs activities – already prior to application – are preconditions for getting the status. After all: The certificate is only granted in case that there haven't been any infringements against customs rules during the last three years.

The target of the certification launched by the World Customs Organization and basing on basic rules of the European Union is the general safeguarding of the international supply chain from the producer of a merchandise up to the final consumer.
